Discover who refugees are, the challenges they face, the process they go through to obtain refugee status, and their everyday experiences.

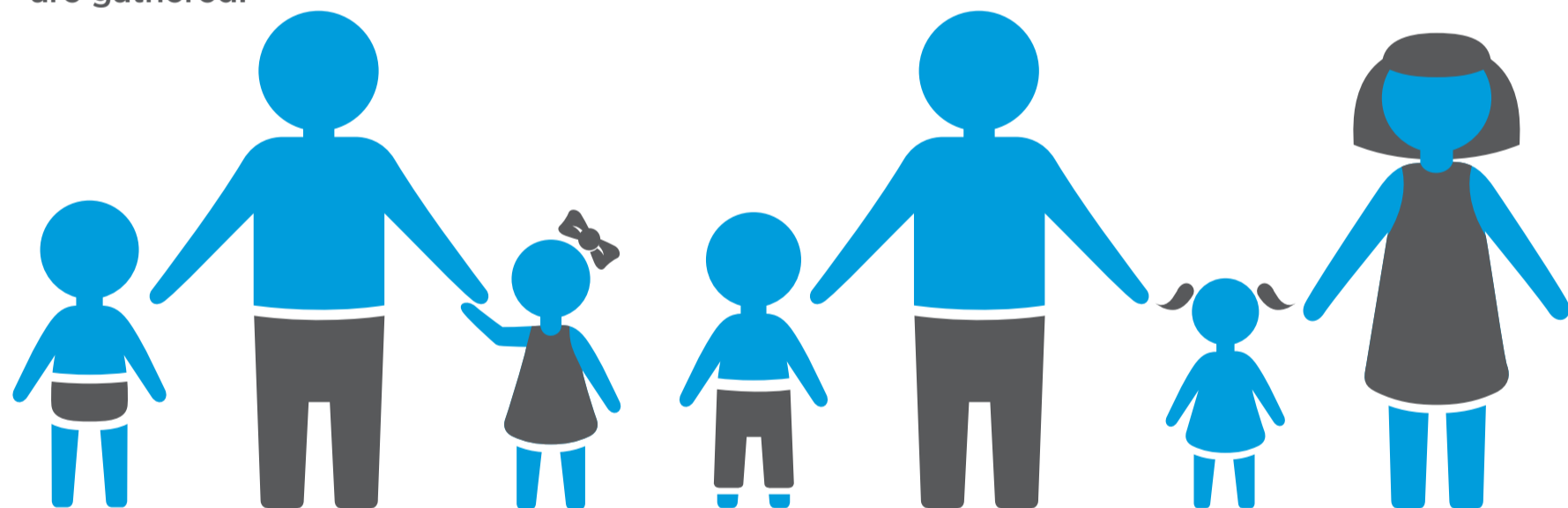
